Adopted January 22, 2015

In order to encourage participation in the governance of the Association and provide transparency regarding policy making, members are invited to attend “open committee” meetings.

Unless there are reasons for confidentiality as determined by the committee chairman, many committee meetings of the Association are open to any member if space allows. Members should e-mail the staff support preferably no later than twenty-four (24) hours before the scheduled meeting to reserve a place and to confirm that the desired meeting is open.

Members attending will have the opportunity to observe the meeting and may offer input when recognized by the committee chairman.
