Essential Elements of a Contract

- Competent Parties
- Mutual Assent (Offer & Acceptance)
- Lawful Objective
- Valuable Consideration



Validity & Enforceability Void or

- Satisfy Statute of Frauds (In writing)

 Not performed within 1 year


